Returning to Work During COVID-19

With many businesses re-opening throughout Ontario, both employers and workers have a responsibility in keeping our workplaces safe during this transition. All workplaces in Ontario are mandated to take precautionary measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19. While many of these measures are a legal requirement, others are at the discretion of the employer.

Workers

- Keep your hands clean
- Keep your environment clean
- Use PPE as required
- Practice physical distancing (2 metres apart)
- Stay home if you're sick



Employers

- Communicate precautions being taken during COVID-19 to workers and customers
 - limited number of customers inside business at one time
 - hand sanitizing stations
 - mandatory PPE requirements for workers
 - hand washing before and after breaks

Ask for help if you feel overwhelmed, you are not alone.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

All workers including new hires and returning workers are required to have training on PPE. The training should include how to properly wear, adjust, maintain as well as possible limitations of the PPE including fit testing for respirators.
