Accident and Incident Program

While the main goal of every health and safety program is to prevent injuries and accidents, the unfortunate reality is that they still happen in many workplaces. In the first half of 2023 alone, Ontario's Workplace Safety Insurance Board (WSIB) reported over 139,000 injury claims.

Workplace incidents and accidents are highly stressful events for everyone involved, especially if they result in a critical injury or fatality. The overwhelming nature of these events often leads to confusion about what steps to take after an event and who is responsible for carrying them out.

The purpose of this newsletter is to help you understand what to do after an incident or accident to prevent similar events from occurring and comply with health and safety legislation.

- ✓ Ensure workers under your direction know the company policy on Injury Reporting
- ✓ Have available materials to secure an accident scene
- ✓ Know who is the First Aid Attendant on your shift(s)
- ✓ Know your role in an Accident Investigation
